I am thankful that we have found a way to keep the Mountain Piano Class going. With Covid-19 protocol and the restrictions we had to change and have class by using the web. We have two students that attend in person and two more that join us through Zoom. We spend part of the class working on songs that we use Hakka evangelism and the other time learning a new song in either Hakka or Mandarin that class members select. I tell them, the people who attend are listening the one who sits up front and is leading the singing, you can just enjoy the music. Just last month we had an activity in the Guan-xin Road Park with Victory Church. One of our class members, Vicky, showed up and played along. She actually had fun and it added to the atmosphere of the event.

Pray with us that the students that we have will be bold and join in when we have events. Pray with us they will enjoy using the songs they have learned to minister to and with the people around them.
