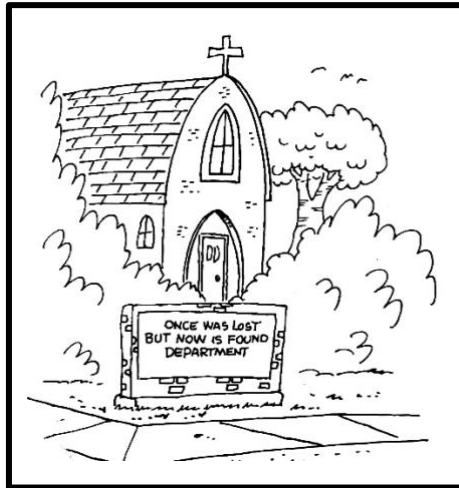

STUDY QUESTIONS

The Wisemen's journey to worship the baby Jesus was probably a 3 to 4 month journey. It was in reality the continuation of a journey that began many centuries earlier and continues yet today. Do you see yourself as part of the journey?

Jesus' journey includes the incarnation, being humbled a little lower than the angels, suffering punishment, and death, now being crowned with glory and honor. How do you react to the reality of Jesus' journey?
